Part I - AROUND TU – IT AWARDS PROGRAM

The **AROUND TU – IT** awards program has been developed to encourage, motivate, create excitement and involve more men through their local churches. It is a program that encourages men to get “around tu – it” for Jesus Christ, a program that will recognize and reward each man’s efforts. Please return the registration form each time you complete a new level in the program.

Level I Bronze coin: To receive the first coin in the awards program, a total of 30 points is required.

Level II Silver coin: To receive the silver coin, a man must first have received the bronze coin and then accumulate an additional 50 points.

Level III Gold coin: To receive the gold coin, a man must have received both the bronze and silver coins and then accumulate an additional 20 points.

Points are accumulated by participating in the following church or service oriented activities:

LEVEL I Bronze coin 30 points required

Points

- 15 Attend a Christian Church (Disciples of Christ) General Assembly
- 15 Attend a local Men’s Retreat
- 10 Volunteer in your community’s food bank
- 5 Serve as a volunteer in a community organization
- 5 Daily devotional reading
- 5 Write an article about men’s ministry for your church newsletter
- 5 Regularly attend the local Men’s Fellowship group
- 3 Attend a church musical program
- 3 Attend a special church educational program
- 3 Participate regularly in church choir or praise band
- 3 Serve as a worship leader in your church
- 3 Attend church services for three Sundays a month (3 points per month, 9 points max for Level I)
- 3 Attend Bible study, small group fellowship or Sunday school three times a month (3 points per month, 9 points max for Level I)

LEVEL II Silver coin 50 points required

Points

- 15 Organize a **Cookin’ for Mission** event with the men at your church

- 15 Bring a new person to your next Men's Retreat
- 15 Read through the Bible in a year
- 15 Attend a spiritual enrichment event, such as Walk to Emmaus or Great Banquet
- 10 Participate in a church or region mission project
- 10 Serve as a camp counselor or director
- 10 Increase your financial contributions to the church by 1% of income
- 10 Give a scholarship so that a ministerial student can attend a spiritual enrichment camp
- 10 Give a scholarship to cover registration for one youth to attend camp
- 5 Serve as an elected officer or committee chair for your local congregation
- 5 Serve as an officer of your local church men's group
- 5 Participate in a men's breakfast, luncheon or dinner program
- 5 Attend a stewardship workshop
- 3 Participate in a workday program at Church Camp
- 3 Serve as a youth volunteer in your local church
- 3 Attend church services for three Sundays a month (3 points per month, 9 points max) in addition to Level I
- 3 Attend Bible study, small group fellowship or Sunday school three times a month (3 points per month, 9 points max) in addition to Level I

LEVEL III Gold coin 20 points required

Points

- 15 Organize a men's fellowship in your church or help another church organize a men's fellowship group
- 15 Give a tithe of your income to the church
- 15 Serve as a mentor to a young man
- 10 Attend worship in a congregation that is ethnically different from your own
- 10 Serve as an officer for any organization of the Christian Church in your state or area
- 10 Serve as an officer of your state or area Disciples Men's Organization
- 5 Represent your Disciples Men's Organization on Men's Ministries at another church (5 per visit, 10 points max)
- 5 Attend a worship service in a style different from your usual service
- 5 Do a home repair for an elderly person (2 hours minimum)
- 5 Visit a nursing home resident or visit a home bound person (3 people minimum)

Remember, all men are now eligible to receive a Certificate of Completion/Registration Form to enter the final phase for the Part II Around Tu-It Awards Program.
