Refugees from Latin America and the Caribbean coming into the United States at the Lower Rio Grande Valley of Texas are supplied with health kits, when they are available. The kits are distributed by the Rev. - Bath Towel
- Wash Cloth
- Bar of Soap
- Shampoo
- Tooth Brush
- Toothpaste
- Deodorant
- Comb
- 1 emery board (not metal)
- 2 band aids
- Small bottle of multi-vitamins
