International Disciples Women's Ministries (IDWM) affirmed that *Just Women*, a quarterly magazine for Disciples women will continue. *Just Women* was originally founded in 2009 as a partnership between IDWM and DisciplesWorld, Inc. IDWM provided all of the seed money to develop and publish *Just Women*; DisciplesWorld, Inc. provided the expertise and infrastructure to launch and publish it. When DisciplesWorld, Inc. announced that it was dissolving, IDWM became the sole publisher. Former *DisciplesWorld* staff are partnering with IDWM to help with a smooth transition.

Adonna Bowman, executive director of the Office of Disciples Women and Secretary/Treasurer of IDWM said, "We anticipate a smooth transition, and while we grieve the loss of *DisciplesWorld*, we embrace the opportunity for *Disciples Women* to publish their own resource."

Judy Row, IDWM President shares. "*Just Women* is committed to continue to address the timely and pertinent issues that affect Disciples Women and the world. We will continue to share articles that will strengthen women's faith, promote justice and minister to the spirit, body and soul."

This June, women from all over the world will gather in Greensboro, North Carolina, for the 2010 Quadrennial Assembly. One of the rich traditions of the past few Quadrennial is the unique tote bags made by our sisters in other countries.

This year, these treasures will be created by our sisters from the Congo. When you carry these bags, you will be linked to your sisters in the Congo. You will also have helped them to provide for their families.

This February 10 to 24, I was part of a delegation that traveled to the Congo. The purpose of the journey will enable us:

- To understand the social, politi-

cal, cultural and economic conditions which shape the lives of the people and churches in the Democratic Republic of Congo (DRC) and the Republic of Congo (RC).

- To be a source of encouragement for the young, growing Disciples community in the Republic of Congo
- To witness the faithfulness of the Community of Disciples of Christ in the DRC as they work to bring spiritual wholeness and a message of hope to its 650,000 members.
- To participate in the dedication of the pediatric wing of the Bolenge Hospital and explore ways of future participation in the medical ministry.
- To witness the work of the

church in areas of health care, education and development

- To promote a continuation of the partnership with Haiti, Congo and African-American churches and seminarians.
- To assist our U.S. churches in understanding our role and that of our government in the plight of the people of the DRC.

We will spend time talking with the leadership of the National Women's Department concerning our involvement with women and children who are victims of the war in the east.

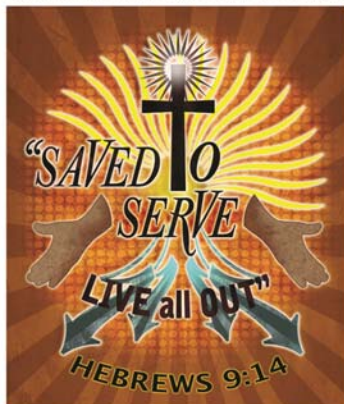
