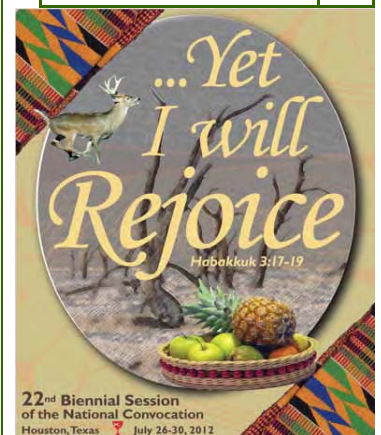

You are invited to create an art logo for the 2014 Quadrennial Assembly. The overall theme of our event is “**I SEE YOU. . .**”. Our daily themes will be:

- I see you through eyes of grace
- I see you through the voice of compassion
- I see you with hands of justice
- I see you with a heart of joy
- I see you whole

While you create this piece, please keep in mind:

- The piece needs to be able to translate to large pieces like posters and banners, but also smaller pieces such as the charms (which are about 1” in size), not to mention t-shirts and any number of other items.
- The piece may be any shape.
- No limit to number of colors used, but must translate well to black & white.

- The theme needs to appear in English, Spanish (Te Veo. . .), and Korean (나는 당신을 봅니다. . .). Quadrennial Assembly 2014 is only in English.
- All pieces need to be submitted to in vector format and in their final form by **May 31th, 2012**. You can employ whatever medium you would like to create your logo submission, as long as there is a vector submission in high and low resolution.

- Resolutions: 300dpi and 72 dpi
- Color : CMYK
- File Types : TIF, PDF or EPS
- If chosen you will be **required** to submit your AI or EPS file.

If your design is chosen, you will receive \$1,000 for the copyright giving the 2014 Quadrennial Assembly permission to use the design as needed.

## Journey to the Congos by Janie Troublefield

*Janie Troublefield was part of the 2012 Woman-to-Woman Worldwide Delegation to the Republic and Democratic Republic of the Congo. This is the first part of a three part series of her reflections*



**Congolese Sisters in Christ**

There were three things that really struck me hard during my visit to the Congo. They are imprinted in my mind as if it were only yesterday that I experienced them. They are in my heart, soul, mind, and spirit. I believe my experiences in the Congo will be with me for the rest of my life. It is truly a journey that only began in August 2011, but has not ended for me and it is now May 2012. I don't want it to end.

The experience of meeting a Congolese sister by the name of Mama Berthe Nzeba grabbed my attention and held me spellbound throughout my time with her. Mama Nzeba has a shelter for women. She has developed a program to teach the women life skills and build their self-esteem. The uniqueness of her program is what I call “each one teach

one.” She teaches the women basic life skills. After learning a skill, (such as canning) the women go back to their various communities/villages and teach the skill to others. This is a far-reaching program that can spread far and wide.

Mama Nzeba is able to reach so many more by her willingness to train those who are able to come to her school, but at the same time her numbers are multiplying as she teaches the women to go back and help their communities. She teaches them to take back home what they learned from her. There is no selfishness in her work; she only wants to help as many as she possibly can. There is a saying in the United States, “A mind is a terrible thing to waste.” I see no waste in



this program. Everyone who enters the doors of Mama Nzeba's program comes with an expectancy to learn, grow, become self-sufficient, and help others. This is the same expectancy they take back to their various communities/villages.

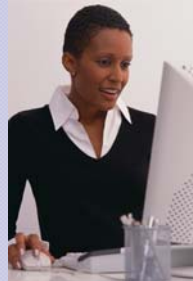
