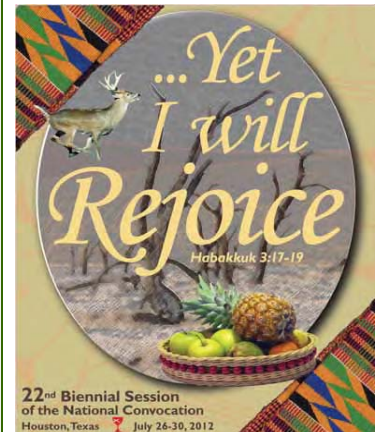

## Celebrating the Life of the Rev. Dr. Billye P. Bridges

National Convocation Disciples Women's Ministry celebrates the life of our colleague Rev. Dr. Billye P. Bridges. She served as Merger Staff for the National Convocation and Director of Christian Education in the General Ministry of Disciples Home Missions.

One of her signature phrases was *"Sheila, I am proud to be a Disciples Woman"* She was a strong supporter, advocate and constant presence at Disciples Women's luncheons at National Convocations and General Assemblies. She wrote for Disciples Women's resources, attended Quadrennial Assemblies, supported *Just Women* magazine, keynoted at Disciples Women's retreats and served as an advisor for the Women's Ministry at her home congregation—Light of the World Christian Church..

Billye was my mentor, colleague, sister-in-Christ, teacher and friend. She always had a smile and a high five. It was an honor to work with her at Disciples Center and worship with her at Light of the World Christian Church.

Rev. Brenda Etheridge, Michigan, shares her personal reflections:

*"Rev. Dr. Billye Bridges was a giving and creative person. She was a collaborator and encourager. Whenever Billye saw you she had a word of praise and adoration to God and affirmation of those in ministry. She worked tirelessly to prepare us for our ministries to our congregations, regions and communities. She will be greatly missed"*

Dr. Bridges wrote an article on Stewardship for the 2008 issue of *Called, Gifted and Sent*. She was always the giver; thus, writing on Stewardship was an appropriate topic. Here is an excerpt from her article. *"The Three Ts of Stewardship"*

*"Women wear many hats, have numerous responsibilities and maintain multiple relationships. How do we prayerfully practice good stewardship of our time? Women are gifted, multi-talented, and usually called in many directions. How do we trust God in becoming good stewards of our talents? How do we wisely seek Godly guidance in becoming good stewards of our treasure?"*

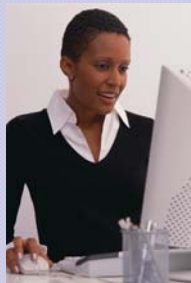
