Welcoming Refugees Through Ecumenical Partnership

A new style of sponsorship is here!! Churches are now asked to consider helping with **AT LEAST THREE** of the following types of welcoming activities to “sponsor” a refugee family. It’s **YOUR CHOICE HOW** to engage—but **DISCIPLES ARE NEEDED AROUND THE U.S.** to help resettle over 1,000 refugees annually who enter through our 34 Church World Service partner offices and are assigned to Disciples for sponsorship!



- Set up an apartment for a new refugee or family,
 - Provide a contribution for rent,



- Gather furniture and household items,
- Stock the pantry with culturally appropriate groceries,



- Meet refugee/s at the airport,
 - Provide a welcoming meal,



- Accompany the refugee/s to a medical appointment,

- Teach basic English or financial literacy education,



- Assist refugees to prepare for a job

- Offer transportation assistance,



- Creatively “tour” the refugees around your neighborhood.

There are more refugees in the world now than **SINCE** World War II.
