URGENT: Tell President Obama We Want to Welcome More Syrian Refugees!

Background

As we grapple with increasingly heartbreaking and tragic reports of Syrian refugees dying as they seek safety in the region and in Europe, it is clear that the United States must respond with leadership.

Thus far, the U.S. has only resettled 1,517 Syrian refugees since the beginning of the conflict! While resettlement is not the only solution, it is a critical way the U.S. can support countries like Lebanon, Turkey and Jordan that are hosting millions of Syrian refugees. The United States can and should resettle at least 100,000 Syrian refugees this coming fiscal year, in addition to increasing our total resettlement commitment from 70,000 to 100,000 refugees from all parts of the world.

In 1980, the U.S. resettled more than 200,000 refugees, showing that where there's a will, there's a way. The U.S. must demonstrate leadership and increase refugee resettlement.
