Disciples Volunteering



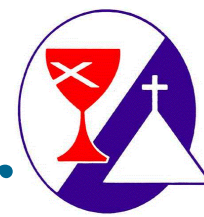
If you're 20-27, you can spend 10 weeks serving as a Disciples Summer Mission Intern. You'll grow in leadership, gain self-awareness, and learn to see and address privilege and injustice (hint: they're everywhere). Global Ministries - Global Mission Interns



College graduates (22-30) who feel called to serve in another country can apply to the Global Mission Intern program for a 1-3 year term with a Global Ministries partner working on issues from human rights to child advocacy. Christmount Retreat Center



Short-Term Volunteers spend 6 weeks - 6 months helping with programs and initiatives. Housing, some meals, and retreat opportunities provided in Black Mountain, NC. Small stipends may be available. Long-Term Volunteers are provided with lodging and will engage in a specific area of focus for 9 months - 1 year, further exploring their calling to a social justice ministry. rob@christmount.org

Young Adult Commission



18-33 year olds can serve the church from their local context by applying for a 3-year term with the Young Adult Commission (YAC) through Disciples Home Missions. YAC connects and empowers young adults to engage in the ministry of the Christian Church. YAC represents Disciples young adults in congregations, regions, and the whole church. This 10-month Residency is for 21-30 year olds exploring connections between the life of faith and the work of justice. The NBA's internship provides housing, health insurance, and a living stipend for young adults seeking their next steps, with locations around the United States. XPLOR invites Residents into mutual journeying with host congregations, community engagement sites, and other young adults who are seeking to live lives of meaning and purpose.
