Site Overview:

Lutheran Family Services (LFS) – Community Services welcomes hundreds of refugees to Nebraska every year, providing comprehensive services to people seeking refuge from violence, oppression and persecution. LFS case workers are knowledgeable and skilled in case management, advocacy, cultural orientation, education, immigration legal services, employment and job readiness training, with the majority of case managers being former refugees themselves. Community Services staff and clients rely heavily on community support for daily tasks such as shopping, social support, financial literacy, and navigating the public transportation system. Community partners serve as guides, friends and advocates to help ensure refugees are acquainted with important aspects of American life, culture and customs.

LFS-Community Services in Lincoln provides direct refugee resettlement, employment case management, intensive extended case management, volunteer and co-sponsor matching, health education, immigration legal
