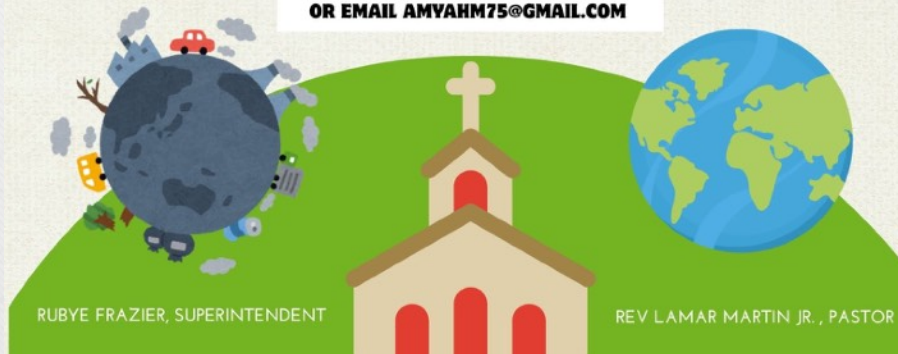

Ministry Response-Action or Initiative

Community Outreach Impact

I developed and implemented an outreach strategy to engage the neighborhoods surrounding the County area, sharing our mission and showing how attending Vacation Bible School could inspire them to put their knowledge into action. I visited local hair stores, libraries, research centers, private-owned businesses, gyms, and recreation centers to spread awareness and invite participation.



With the approval of a local leasing manager, I organized a community clean-up in partnership with an apartment complex. After the clean-up, families enjoyed uplifting gospel music, ice cream, games, and activities as incentives to care for our shared space. Children learned the importance of proper waste sorting by helping collect and separate plastic, glass, paper, and other materials into labeled bags.

During Vacation Bible School, I led arts and crafts activities centered around faith and environmentalism, supporting the Green Chalice initiative.

Projects included planting grass seeds in front of miniature houses, painting flower pots, and planting rose bushes around the church grounds.

Impact and Ripples

1) In total, we contacted 15 community centers, distributed over 200 flyers, and saw a 90% attendance rate from registered youth. We had a total of 27 Children and 25 Adults attend in support of our program.

2) This program also paved the way for future partnerships and collaborations with Fellowship Christian Church with the organizations involved.

3) This Program also allowed for ministry in the field, where we were able to meet others and share the gospel with them. Additionally, it helped increase church attendance by inviting those who were seeking a church home.
