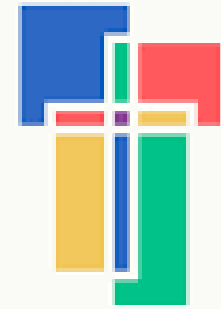
Ministry Response
